How have UT Proposals Historically Worked?

Once upon a time...

- Mainstage proposals were due 3rd week of the quarter prior to the performing quarter
- Workshops were due **6**th **week** of the quarter prior to the performing quarter
- Shows would take the rest of that prior quarter to prepare designs, talk to Pro Staff, etc. (Design Conference 7th week, Uber Prod 10th week)
- Auditions happened the first week of the performance quarter
- Shows go up anywhere between 6th and 10th week
- All Mainstage shows got \$2,500, all Dean's Men FXK shows got \$1,500, Workshops got \$250

The (Proposed) Proposal Process

Types of Work

- 1. One-Quarter Shows Performances take place in the FXK, Theater East, or Theater West during 7th or 8th week each quarter and are passed one quarter prior to the quarter of their performance. All Dean's Men shows are One-Quarter shows, with the exception of the spring trunk show.
- 2. Cross-Quarter Shows Performances take place Theater East or Theater West during the 6th week of Winter and Spring Quarter and are passed two quarters prior to the quarter of their performance. The cross-quarter model is intended for productions that want more flexible rehearsal scheduling, increased rehearsal time to accommodate performance duration, and/or additional time to develop design elements.
- **3. Collaborations** RSOs may propose to collaborate with UT to produce one-quarter and cross-quarter shows.
- **4. Site Specific Work** Performance pieces and installations that are located in Logan 501 or other locations on campus. These may be one-quarter or cross-quarter shows, depending on location.
- 5. **Workshops** Performances take place during 5th week of Fall and Winter Quarters and are passed one quarter prior to the quarter of their performance through the beginning of the performance quarter. Workshops are intended for works, particularly new or student-written work, with a shorter runtime and minimal stage design.

Budgeting (Proposed)*

Cross-Quarter - up to \$5,000

One-Quarter - up to \$3,000

Workshops - up to \$250

Collaborations & Site-Specific - varies

Timeline:

2nd Week (Fri): Proposals Due

A proposed rough budget to the nearest \$500 is due

3rd Week (Fri): Shows Announced

8th Week (Fri): Uber Prod Budget Finalized

Itemized budgets due to Committee, and may be adjusted up to \$500 from proposed budget (w/i cap)

9th Week: Uber Prod

Itemized budgets presented to pro-staff during Uber Prod

3rd Week (Fri) (Performance Quarter)

Deadline by which One-Quarter and Cross-Quarter shows may apply for up to \$1,000 beyond Uber Prod budget

*We are still trying to figure out what an appropriate budget and budget timeline would look like for each show and would love your feedback!

Proposing Quarter Timeline

2nd Week, Friday 5pm: written mainstage proposals and scripts due to Committee

3rd Week: proposers meet with Committee members individually

3rd Week, Friday 5pm: public mainstage proposal meeting + Q&A

3rd Week, Friday evening: mainstages are passed + announced by Committee

5th Week, Friday 5pm: workshops and site-specific work proposals due

6th Week, Monday 5pm: public workshops and site-specific work proposal meeting

6th Week, Monday evening: workshops and site-specific works are passed

8th Week, Friday: mainstage final budgets submitted prior to Uber Prod in 9th week

Performance Quarter Timeline

1st Week, Tuesday through Thursday: auditions

3rd Week, Friday: last day to submit a budget extension request for shows performing in current quarter

4th/**5**th **Week:** workshop performances

6th-8th Week: performances of Single-Quarter show(s) and Cross-Quarter show (passed two quarters prior)
